The Long Hill Township Library is a cornerstone of our community. It's a place to gather, read, and learn, and it's busier than ever! Circulation is skyrocketing, story times are more frequent (and even happening at Stirling Lake!), and there were more than 4,600 participants in the summer programs for children.

The Library is also a place to play. This year, people visited the Library to unleash their inner artists through art classes and flower arranging. You danced, played board games and mini-golf, watched movies, attended concerts, learned about pyramids, eels, and Vikings, savored the chocolate fountain, and much more. At the September Sunday Funday, over 600 of you spent an afternoon connecting with neighbors and having fun!

Recently, the Library sent out its first Community Survey. More than 1,000 residents took the time to share what they want and we are listening! The Library offers more:

- Weekend and evening programming. Check the Library calendar for events.
- **Computer and e-book assistance.** Learn about technology at Wired Wednesday or stop in at any time for one-on-one e-book help.
- **Partnerships with local schools.** Participated in Environmental Day, attended Back to School Night, encouraged school field trips to the Library, and held Library Card Day for 91 kindergartners.
- **Community engagement at outside events.** Partnership with the Senior Center, the Chamber of Commerce, Township Recreation Department, Lounsberry Meadows, Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts, ArtAbled, and others.
- Author talks and readings. You can meet many of your favorite big-name authors on Zoom through the Library Authors program offered three to four times per month.
